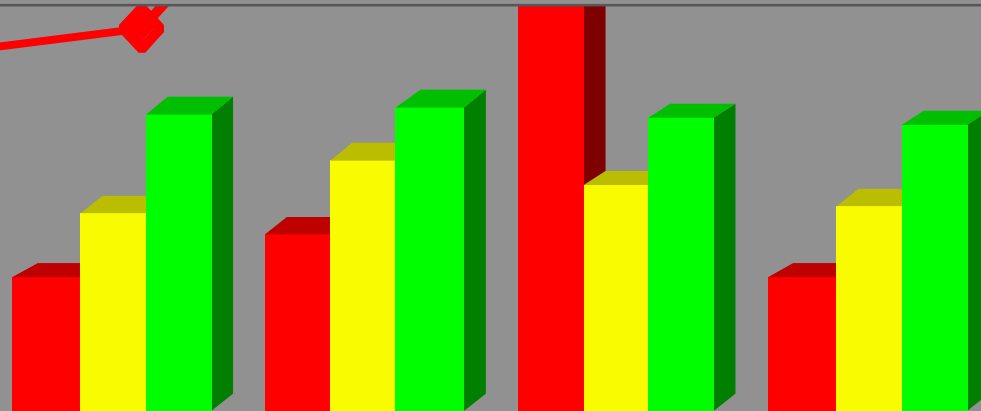


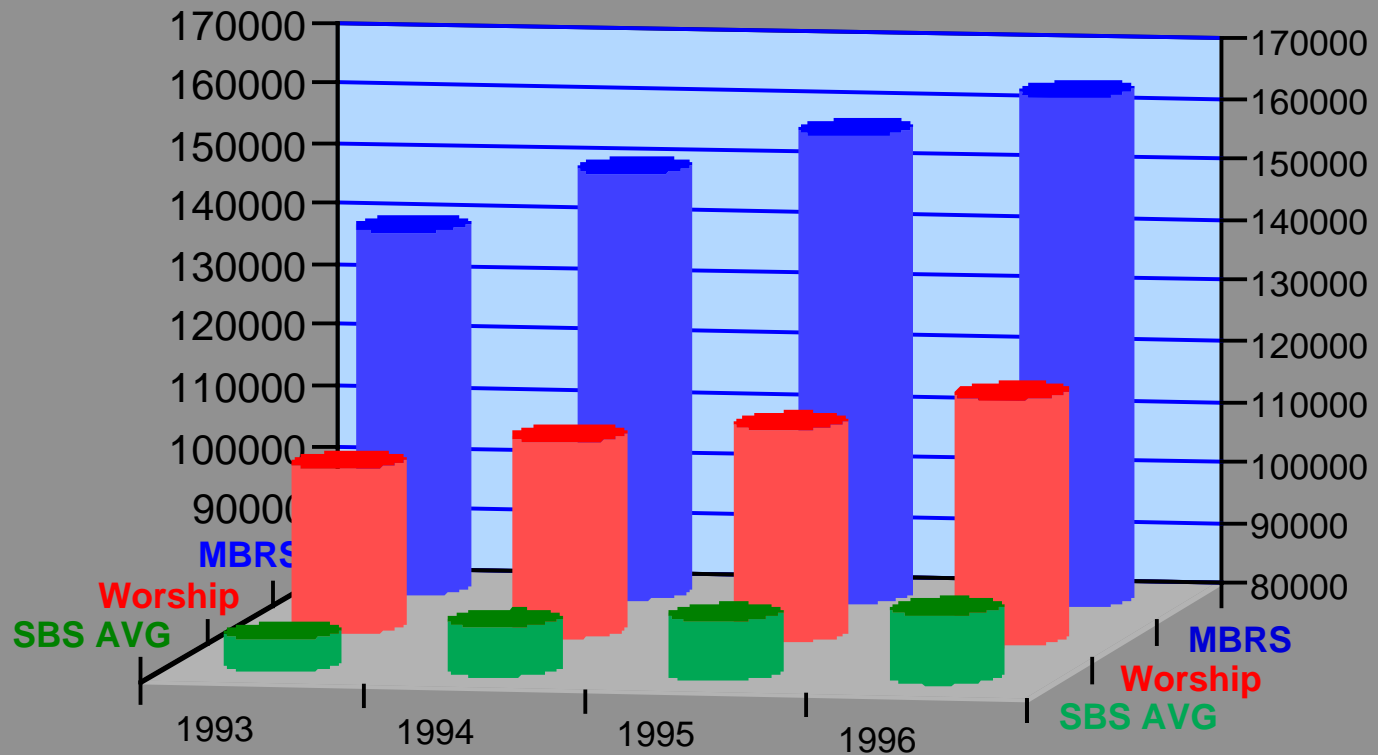

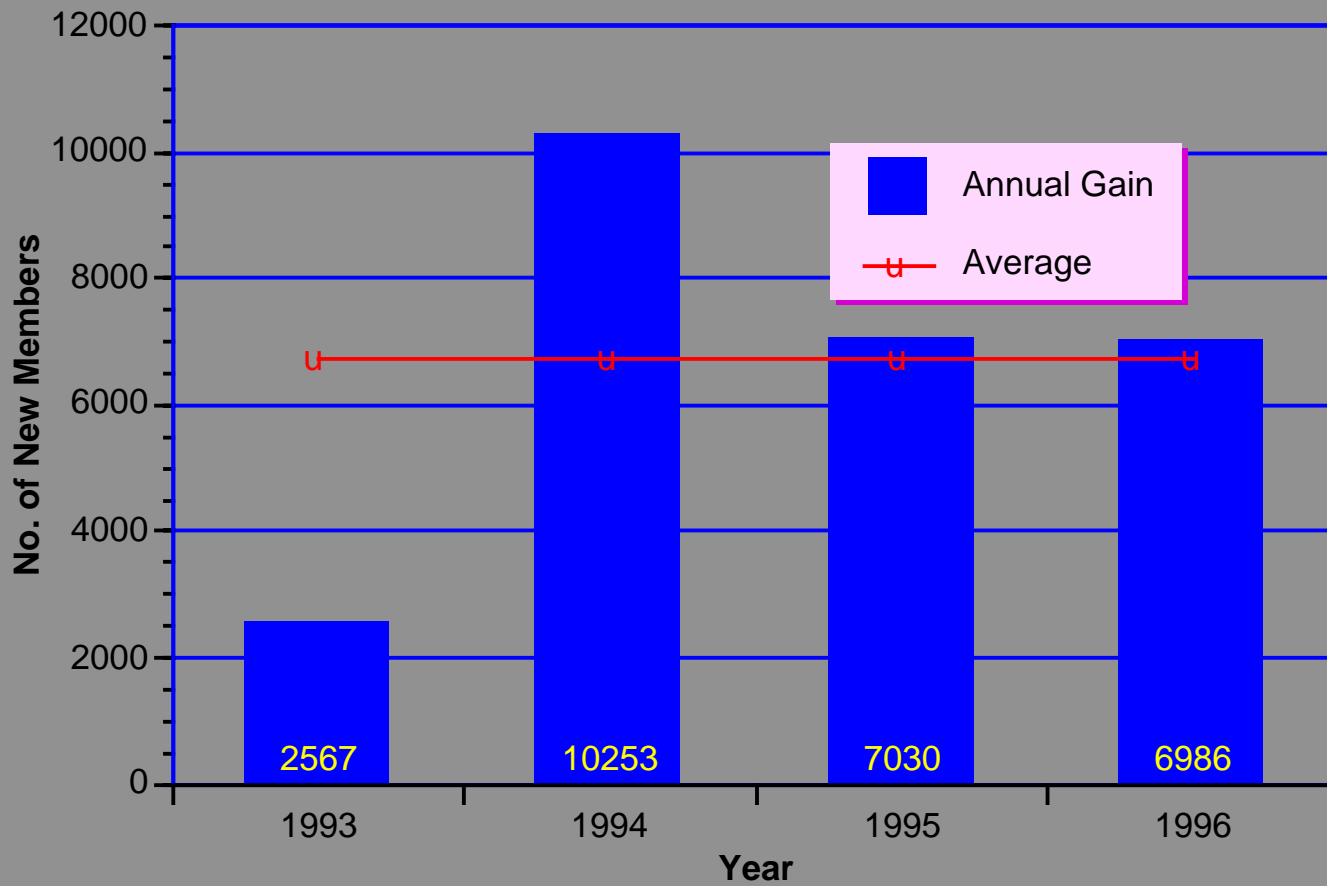
Introduction

- QGR = Quadrennial Growth Rate (1993-1996)

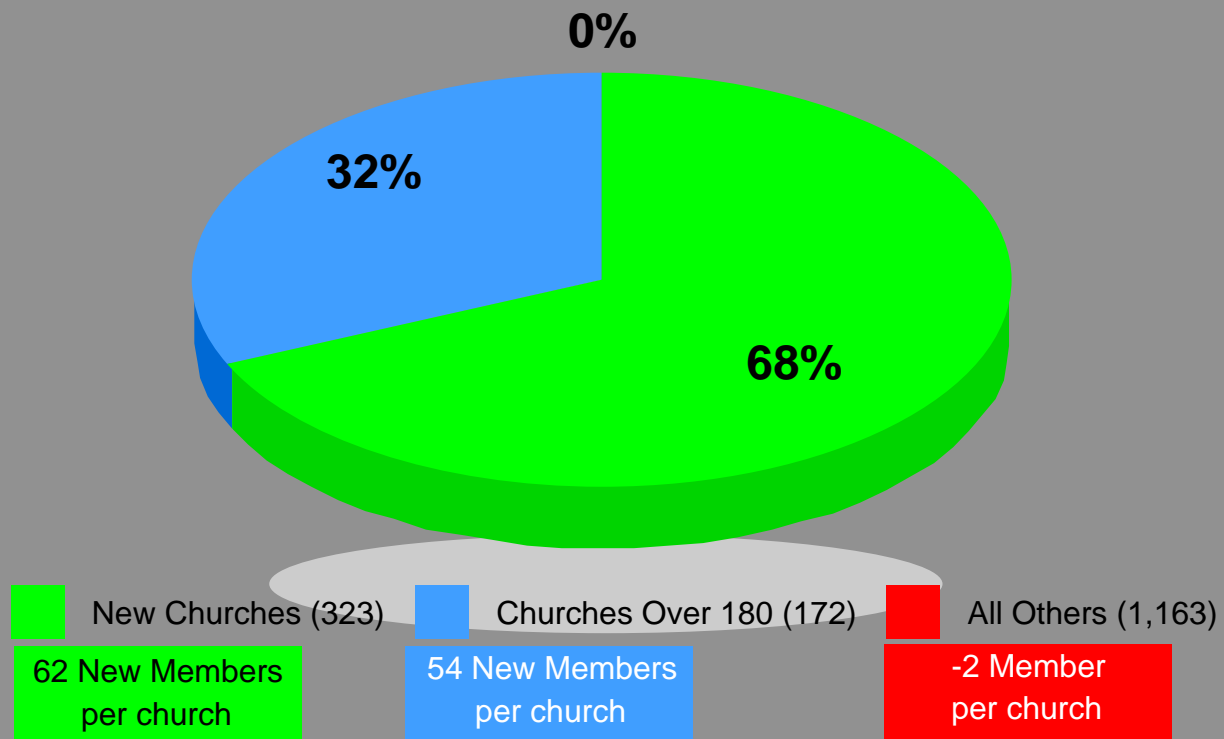
Decadal Growth



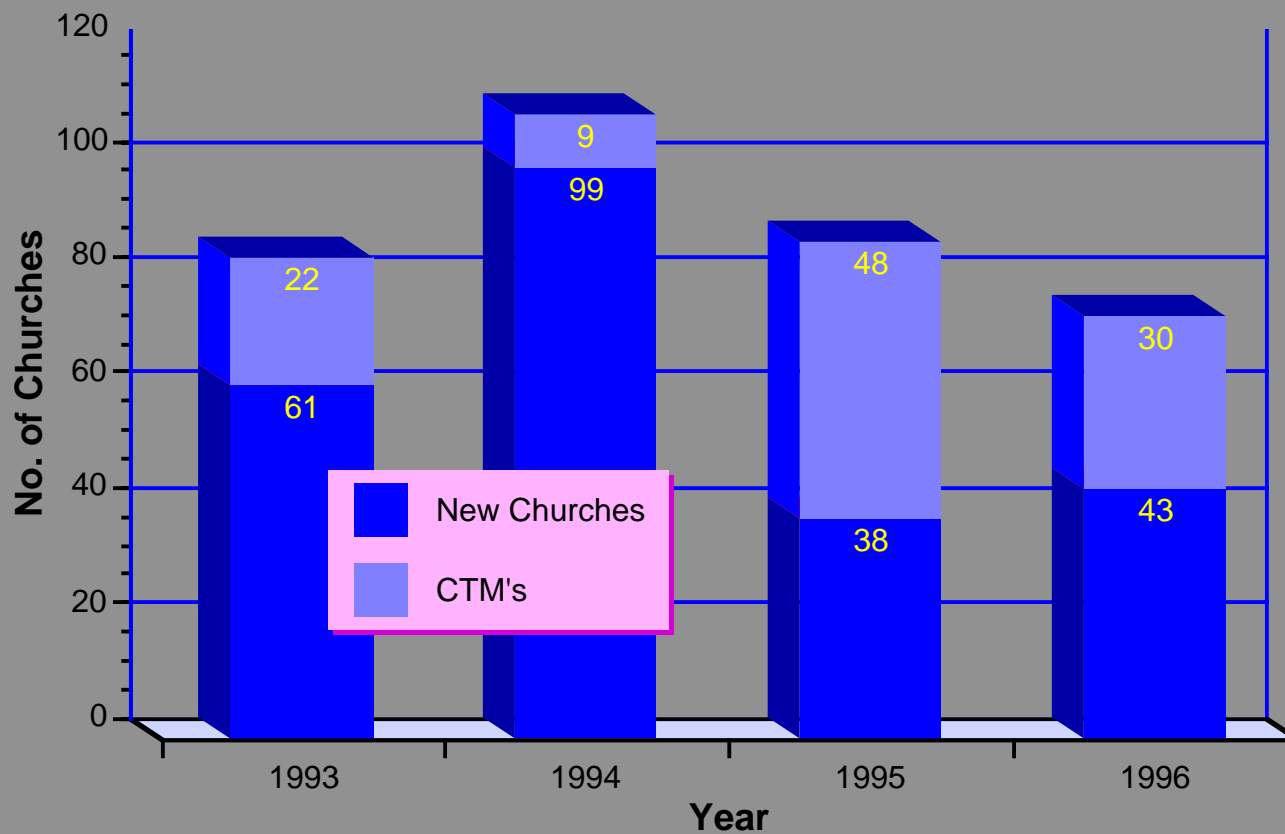
Annual Gain In Members



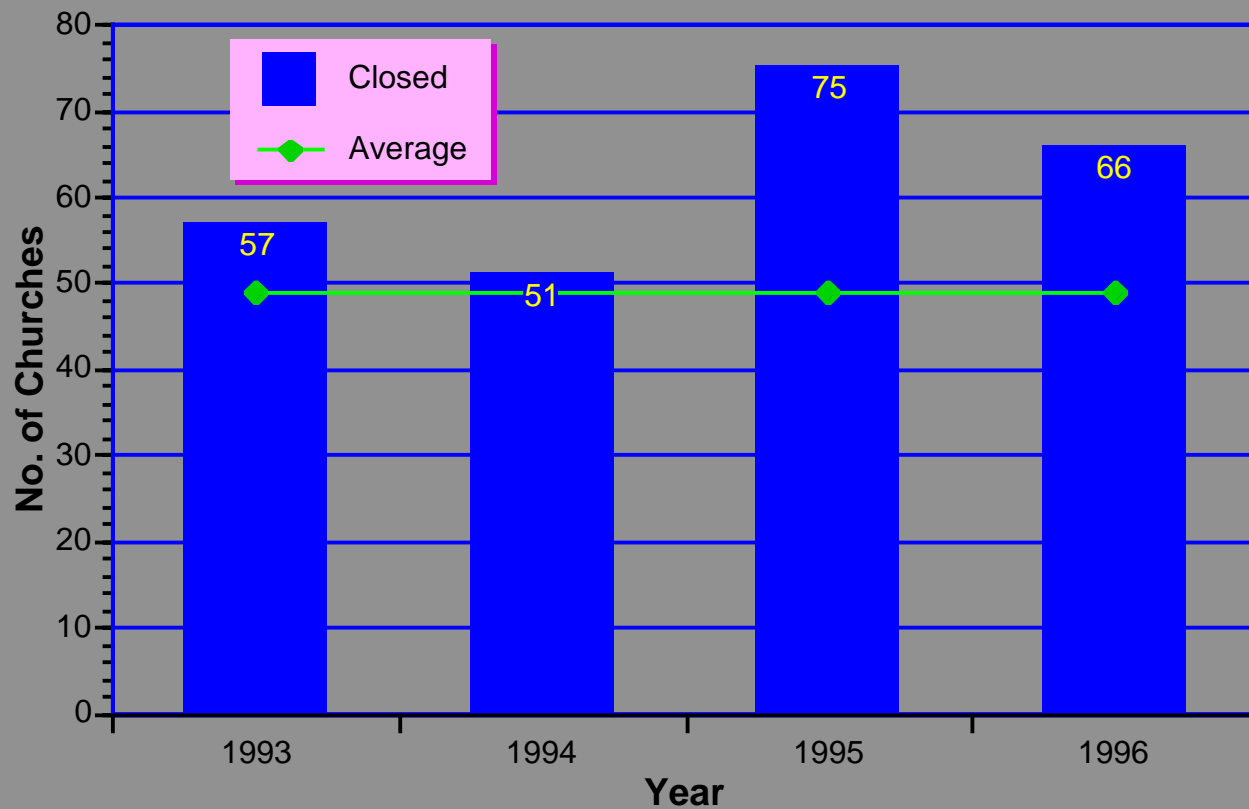
Source of New Members



New Churches



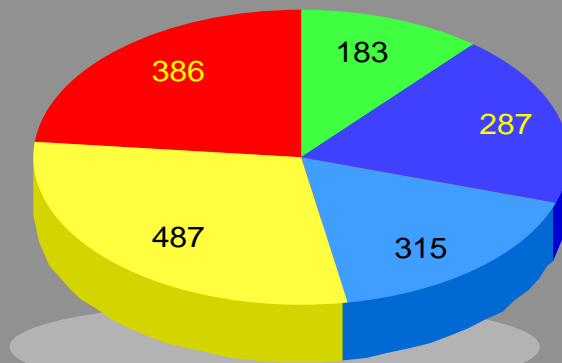
Closed Churches



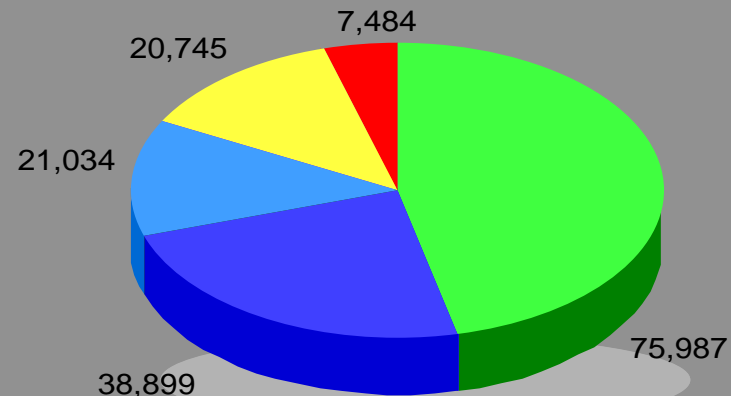

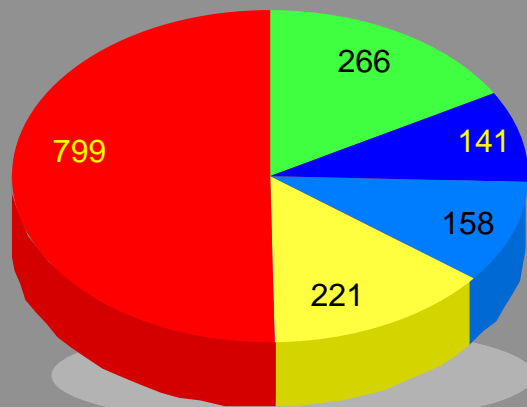

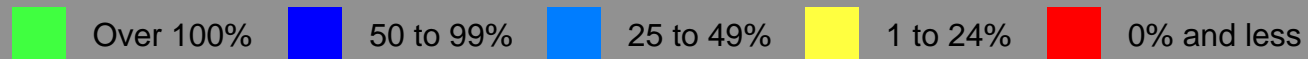
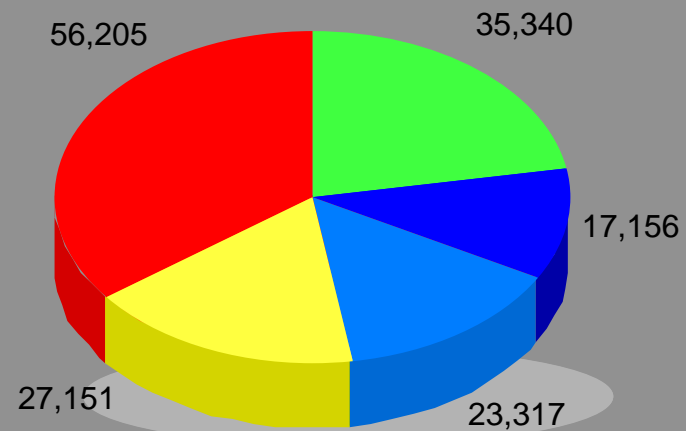
Growth Rates of Churches

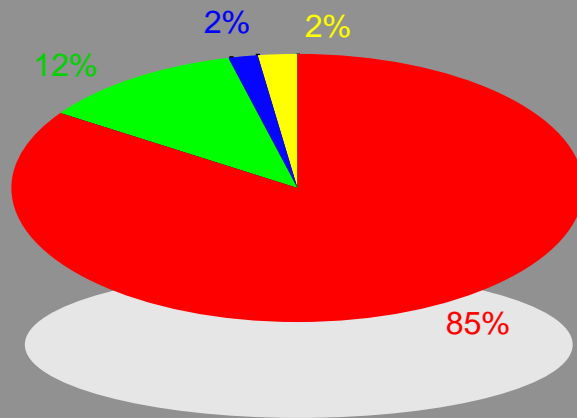

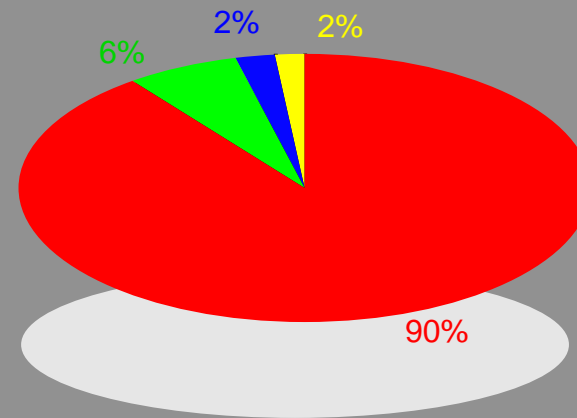
Ethnicity of Churches

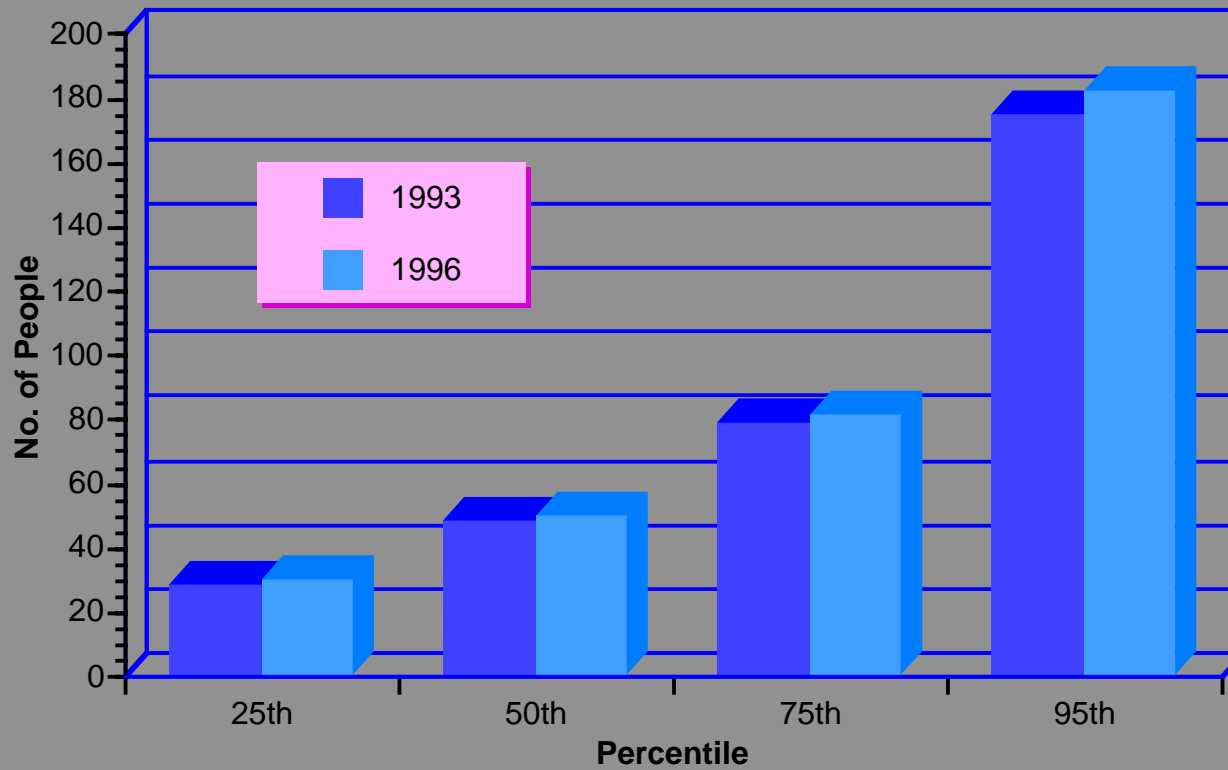
